Even after his time at the national level, Terry's commitment never wavered. He returned to the Alberta board, continuing to give his time and expertise as 2nd Vice President from 2007 to 2009, demonstrating that for him, service was never about position, but about passion.

Terry also played a role in one of the most memorable milestones in our sport's history. In 1998, he coached Team Alberta at the very first Youth Challenge Nationals in Gatineau, where they captured the inaugural national championship a moment that set the tone for excellence and pride that continues to this day.

But beyond the titles and accomplishments, what truly defined Terry was the way he led. He was a steady voice, a mentor to many, and someone who always believed in building something stronger for those who would follow. His efforts helped shape the direction of 5 Pin Bowling in Alberta, guiding it through growth and change, and helping lay the foundation for the success we continue to see today.

A lifetime membership is not just about years of service, it is about impact. It is about the lives touched, the standards set, and the legacy left behind.

Terry McLeod's legacy lives on in the organizations he helped strengthen, the programs he helped build, and the countless individuals he inspired along the way.
